Since the installation of the Learning Logic Algebra Computer Lab (LL²) at Collinwood High School in January of 1993, math performance of our students continues to improve.

There has been a great reduction of drop-outs in math and students who previously dropped out, have returned to complete the course in the "LL²" lab. The reason most often expressed for this positive attitude is the self-pacing feature of "LL²". Grades are much higher, with students getting A's and B's. Again, this is attributed to the self-paced, mastery learning concept.

I have attached statistics that we have monitored, as well as comments from "LL²" installations in other parts of the country.

Three payments have been made in the five-year lease and according to the original five-year plan, we are requesting funding for the final two years remaining in the lease which amounts to \$32,035 per year.

We are extremely satisfied in the progress thus far shown in the "LL²" lab, especially in a critical subject matter such as math.
